The Antioch Traveling Closet was formed in 2014 with a recruited handful of volunteers that has quickly grown to a widespread community effort supported through the Village of Antioch residents and local businesses.

**What does Antioch Traveling Closet do?**

Our mission for the ATC is to make sure that no child, adult, or senior citizen is without basic items that we sometimes take for granted. Items as simple as a toothbrush and toothpaste. The ATC collects donated items from the community such as gently used shoes, clothing, winter jackets, boots, hats, gloves, books and toiletries. They are then distributed, free of charge, at quarterly giveaway drives. The residents in our community range from senior citizens, single parents, grandparents raising their grandchildren, Veterans, and families simply upon tough times. On a first come, first serve basis, the residents of our community can come and shop for whatever items they are in need of, FREE OF CHARGE. No questions asked.
